NEW ER DOCTOR PROGRAM

Our New ER Doctor Program (NERD) is designed to prepare recent DVM grads and practicing non-emergency veterinarians for a career as highly skilled, confident VEG ER doctors. Doctors in the program engage in an immersive training experience: they receive practical training while working alongside skilled doctors and attending weekly rounds. Through exposure to a wide variety of cases, doctors in the NERD program discover the unique rewards of customerfocused ER. New ER doctors receive over 160 hours of RACE-approved CE and individualized mentorship throughout the program. They emerge from the program feeling confident to take on any case that walks through the door. We host the program four times throughout the year, with new classes starting in January, April, July, and October.

Program structure

- Average of three to four 12-hour clinical shifts per week
- Log your surgeries and procedures to evaluate and maximize learning
- Two trips for hands-on CE in surgery, exotics, critical care, ultrasound, and endoscopy
- Weekly NERD class including topic rounds, exotics cases, journal club, leadership development, and Q & A.
- Daily mentorship on the floor from senior doctors and 1:1 mentorship via check-ins and goal-setting with your Medical Director

NERD TIMELINE


your path to unparalleled learning opportunities from the industry leader

Our fast-paced, 6-month timeline is designed to keep you learning both clinically and didactically, supplemented with hands-on training labs. Each step of the way, you'll receive mentorship and feedback to ensure you get the most out of the program.



months 1-2

You'll start off by taking simple cases and moving on to more complex cases and disease processes. We instill a better understanding of the hospital's culture and workflow. As your confidence and skills increase, you can be the primary doctor on more complex and critical cases (DKAs, UOs, GDVs, etc.)



month 4

Opportunity to run the show with your senior doctor in the background for guidance. You should be mostly independent at this point: directing the team & owning client communication, while still talking through treatment plans with the senior doctor. A mid-point exam takes place to identify where we can help support you for the remainder of the program!



graduation

Your final is a case presentation that you have seen and managed on the floor! Congrats, you're a VEG ER doctor!



Week 1 is orientation, which includes overviews of the program and curriculum, and an introduction to topics such as Approach to a Case, History-Taking/Medical Records, and Workflow in the Busy VEG ER.



month 3


A mid-program review is where you'll receive feedback from the senior doctors and support staff at your hospital. This is an opportunity to identify areas of improvement to work on for the last few months of the program.



month 5-6

During this time, your senior doctor will be present, however you should be acting independently for the most part. You may even have the opportunity to be the leaders on a paired practice shift with a fellow NERD without a senior doctor!





MENTORSHIP

expert guidance and support

In training programs, mentorship is often promised but not delivered. In the NERD program, you receive mentorship on a daily, weekly, and monthly basis. You will work alongside another ER doctor on every shift - improving your confidence and approach to every case throughout the program. You will have the ability to ask the senior doctor you are working with about diagnostics, treatment plans, and client communication questions.

Mentors by your side:

DAILY Clinical mentorship on-shift from an associate doctor

WEEKLY Written feedback on your approach to a case and topics you are learning in class; office hours with Director of New ER Doctor Education

MONTHLY Growth-focused goal-setting meetings with your Medical Director

The New ER Doctor program is an investment in your learning and development as an emergency doctor. Over the course of the program, NERDs are taught by 8 criticalists, 5 exotics specialists, 5 surgeons, 3 cardiologists, 3 sonographers, an ophthalmologist, a radiologist, an anesthesiologist, and many of our very own VEG doctors and medical directors. From hands-on skills training to weekly didactic learning, program participants earn over 160 RACE-approved CE hours in just 6 months – this takes most doctors 10 years to accomplish!


VEG fosters a community of caring, partnership, and fun
